ADMISSION GUIDELINES

Admission Policy:

- Since the college is a Government Educational Institution it follows the rules and regulation framed by the Government of Tamilnadu. In respect to Under Graduate Courses, According to the rules and regulations of the Department of Collegiate Education of Tamil Nadu Government, those students who have passed +2 can apply to the colleges. The students are admitted in the college, as per the community roster. The ranking is computed after calculating the +2 marks obtained by the student. The marks in the subject choice of the student to join the Undergraduate course, play an important role in determining not only the rank but also his selection to that particular department.
- Prospectus is issued along with the application form for joining UG and PG courses. The prospectus contains the details of courses offered by the college eligibility and criteria. As per the rule of Government of Tamilnadu no Tuition fee for the students. Only a nominal fee is charged for both UG and PG courses.
- The upper age limit for admission to UG courses will be 21 (twenty one) year as on 1st July on the year of admission. However a relaxation of 5 years is permitted for Differently abled as per G.O.MsNo 239, S.W dated 3-9.93. SC/ST/AC/MBC/DNC candidates and women candidates may be allowed for the age relaxation of 3 years beyond 21 years for the admission of UG Courses

Rule of Reservation

The admission shall be made purely on the basis of Merit subject to the rule of reservation of the Government of Tamilnadu.

- 31% for open Competition (OC)
- 30% for Backward Classes within this 3.5% earmarked for Muslims
- 20% for Most Backward (MBC) and Denotified communities(DNC)
- In the 18% for Scheduled castes (sc), 3 % of seats offered to Arunthathiyar (within the seats reserved for SC
- 1% reserved for Scheduled Tribes (ST)

Admission Process: The College being a Government institution, the management strictly follows the admission procedures of the Government. So the deserving students are admitted according to the communal reservation of the Government. Naturally, above 90% of the students come from remote rural areas and from the weaker sections of the society. The list of the selected candidates based on merit will be displayed on the notice board of the college. The admission committee consisting of the senior professors will scrutinize and admit the

students according to the guidelines of the University and the Government. There will always be a member of the SC/ST to approve the selection list.

Rank List

- For admission to Under Graduate courses (UG) a candidate must have passed the higher Secondary Examinations of Tamil Nadu or an examination (like the CBSE) recognised by the Universities as equivalent thereto. Admission should be made based on the +2 marks only.
- The Rank list will be out of 1200 marks comprising a subject-component of 800 and admission to Government Colleges should be through counseling.
- Rank list is prepared based on the marks obtained by the students Rank in the subject component out of total 800 marks under Part III in higher secondary examination. Eligibility of students for admission to UG courses in the college shall be as per the guidelines fixed by the university concerned. Appointment of seat for each course with different stream (80% academic 20% Vocational) and also appointment of seats among students who have studied different subject in the Higher Secondary (+2) shall be made as per the existing norms.
