I am to state that in the G.O. cited Government have issued detail Guidelines with regard to admission of students into arts and science colleges. Further to the Guidelines the following illustration is issued with regard to allocation of seats under sports quota.

If the total number of seats is 600 in first year. 3% is allotted for Sports Quota.

3% of 600 = $(3/100) \times 600 = 18$ seats.

ST(1%)	0.18

Even if the seat is not available for ST in a particular College, if ST Sports candidate comes for admission, he may be allotted the seat adjusting from the other seats.

The Sports quota seats should be allocated in the respective community. It is also stated that there should not be any violation in the seats allocated under various communities.

As per the orders issued in the G.O. second cited, the differently abled students belonging to all communities are exempted from paying special fee.
